Dr. Valyncia C. Raphael, J.D. is the Director of Diversity, Compliance, and Title IX Coordinator at Cerritos College in Southern California. There, she coordinates the College's comprehensive equity, diversity, inclusion initiatives for over 23,000 students and employees. She also leads the College's prevention of and response to gender and sex based discrimination, which includes responses to sexual harassment, stalking, sexual assault, and dating/domestic violence.

Anton has facilitated a support group for survivors of intimate partner and sexual violence; operated as the Sexual Assault Response Coordinator and Domestic Abuse Victim Advocate at a U.S. Navy installation; lobbied for legislation on behalf of victims of sexual assault in the District of Columbia, and worked with victims of violence in criminal, civil and family court settings in Maryland.
